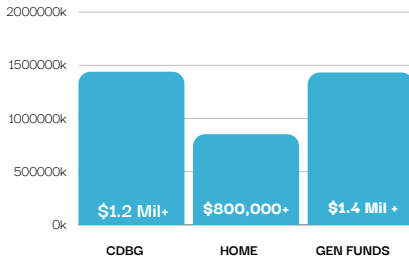


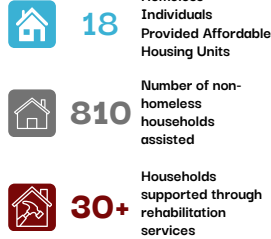

FY24 New Funding Sources

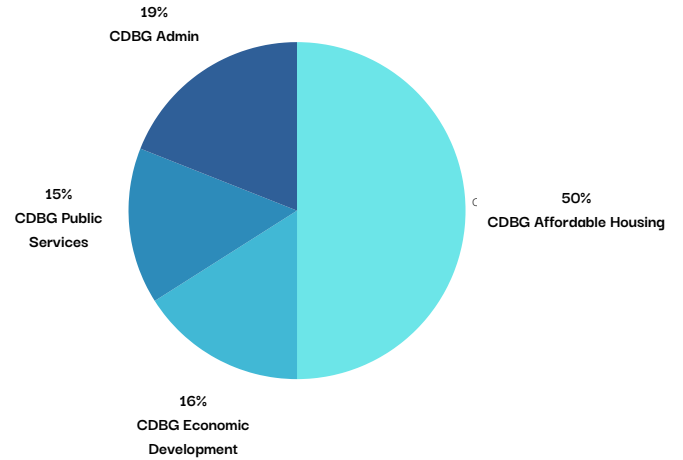


Households Assisted

Households Served by Income Level



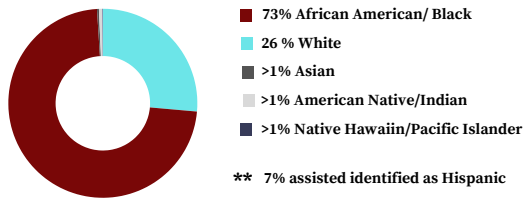

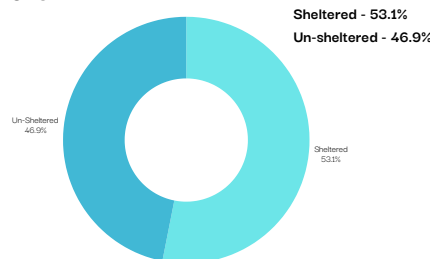

Point-In-Time (PIT) Count

The Point in Time count is a count of sheltered & un-sheltered individuals who are experiencing homelessness on a single night.

The number of sheltered homeless individuals increased by 22% when compared to data from 2023.



132 Permanent Supportive Housing Beds Available

177 Emergency Shelter Beds for those Experiencing Homelessness or Fleeing Domestic Violence
