

Landscape Maintenance **ROW ROUTES**

FREQUENCY	ACTIVITY DESCRIPTION
Three- Four Week Cycle Gateway/Parkways	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Mow all urban and other road profile grassed areas (March – November). 2. Side trim encroaching limbs to maintain clear zone for vehicle and pedestrian passage and lines of sight. (March –November). 3. Spray weeds in concrete curbs sidewalks and islands, in tree mulch rings and around posts. 4. Remove heavy accumulations of debris from intersection triangles, concrete medians, and curb sections as needed. <p style="text-align: center;">Remove all roadside litter. (Year round).</p>
Five-Six Week Cycle Urban Routes	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Mow all urban and other road profile grassed areas (March – November). 2. Side trim encroaching limbs to maintain clear zone for vehicle and pedestrian passage and lines of sight. (March –November). 3. Spray weeds in concrete curbs sidewalks and islands, in tree mulch rings and around posts. <p style="text-align: center;">Remove all roadside litter. (Year round).</p>
Eleven-Week Cycle Rural Routes	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Mow rural road profile shoulders and front slopes. (March – November). 2. Side trim encroaching limbs to maintain clear zone for vehicle and pedestrian passage and lines of sight. (March –November). 3. Spray incidental weeds in concrete areas and at posts and guardrails <p style="text-align: center;">Remove all roadside litter. (Year round)</p>
Biannually	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Edge curb lines and sidewalk edges. (June & November). 2. Pull or trim weeds too large to spray. (June & November).
Annually	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Prune planted trees and shrubs. (January – February). 2. Fertilize trees, shrubs and groundcover or turf areas. (March) 3. Clear large areas of brush <u>if</u> encroachment to road function exists. (November – February). 4. Perform landscape planting and enhancement projects. (November – February).
Continuously	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Remove dead or hazardous tree limbs and trees. 2. Restore damaged areas of grass or landscape plantings.

As Needed	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Perform special project duties.2. Support emergency storm response actions.
