

## **ACC Leisure Services Department Program Modification Parameters**

We understand that some of our program participants requiring modification need additional support and may exhibit some needs and/or behaviors that other participants do not, however there are limits to what we can modify and accommodate. Below are some of the parameters around what modifications we will provide.

- All campers must be independent with hygiene skills and with medication. We do not provide toileting assistance, feeding, or other personal care. With the exception of emergency medications (i.e., epi-pen, Diastat, glucagon), participants must be able to independently administer/take their medication.
- Program participants must be able to maintain a safe environment for themselves and others. Our staff are not certified to, nor will they, restrain a child. If a participant is exhibiting escape behaviors, self-injury and/or aggression towards other participants or staff, we will follow the guidelines in our Code of Conduct and will need to discuss whether continued participation is appropriate. We reserve the right to terminate participation of a child who cannot maintain a safe environment.
- Participants must be able to participate in program activities, with appropriate assistance. However, if we encounter a participant who is unwilling to take part in the majority of activities (or a modified version of them), we will need to discuss continued participation. We provide modification for our programs, but we do not provide an individualized curriculum that is grossly different from what other participants are experiencing. Doing so crosses the line into specialized services, and that is not our purpose.
